



Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)

The Artists Association of Nantucket (AAN) is committed to providing equal access to its programs, services, and activities in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

All participants registering for AAN classes, workshops, camps, events, exhibitions, and other programs are encouraged to share any information regarding accommodations, support needs, or accessibility considerations that may help ensure a positive and successful experience. For participants under the age of 18, this information may be provided by a parent or guardian.

Any information shared regarding accommodations will be reviewed confidentially and used solely for the purpose of determining appropriate support and accessibility measures.

AAN will make reasonable accommodations for qualified individuals with disabilities, provided such accommodations do not fundamentally alter the nature of the program or create an undue burden on the organization. When appropriate, AAN staff may work collaboratively with participants, parents or guardians, instructors, and program staff to identify and implement reasonable accommodations that support meaningful participation and access.

Individuals requesting accommodations are encouraged to contact AAN as early as possible prior to the start of a program so that reasonable arrangements can be made.
