Eric Holch grew up in Andover MA and Greenwich CT, and spent summers on Nantucket Island. He graduated from Hobart College (1970) and, after a stint in the US National Guard, started his advertising career at the Kohler Company in Riverside CT. At the the same time he was starting a career as a fine artist and in 1976 finished his first serigraph print. In 1985 he opened up his own advertising agency, Holch Advertising in New Canaan CT. Simultaneously his serigraph prints were being represented by over 250 galleries in the US, Japan, Australia, Germany and Bermuda. In the early '90's, Holch and his wife, Betsy, moved to Nantucket and opened the Eric Holch Gallery (www.ericholch.com) to focus primarily on his art career and licensing. His necktie designs for Alynn Neckwear also became internationally recognized and are still available today. His latest collaboration is with Gilson Snow designing limited edition snowboards and skis featuring his designs. He always credits his experience in advertising and marketing as a huge help in promoting his artwork and contributed to the success of his art career.

Holch's board membership endeavors started with Country Club of New Canaan and Waveny Care Center. After moving to Nantucket he helped start Nantucket Community Sailing and spent 12 years on the Nantucket Conservation Foundation, preserving and maintaining open space. He was Commodore of the Nantucket Yacht Club after spending 15 years involved with the club and several major building renovations. Most recently he was involved with the start-up of the Egan Maritime Foundation and headed up the building of the Shipwreck and Lifesaving Museum, the restoration of a 1940 Monomoy Surfboat to be used in children's programming and the creation of the Nantucket-centric weather app and website: ACKweather and ACKweather.com
